A quick overview for Lamoille County

STEP 1

Encourage them, or actively assist them, to call the Econcomic Services Division (ESD) of the state of Vermont & ask for emergency shelter: 1-800-775-0506 - If it's after hours, use 2-1-1 instead.

Eligibility is families with custody of children under age 19.

Households with a medically vulnerable individual. They will be placed in a motel. >>>

ALTERNATIVE TO STEP 1

Lamoille Community House is a shelter in Hyde Park for people over the age of 18.
A safe sanctuary with 21 beds.
Call them to get on their waitlist.

Family shelter is an option. Call LCH for availability.

There is also the Recuperative Care Program through LCH that provides medical respite care and housing.
